"Dancing on the Rock"

Dance-A-Rama 2007, North Little Rock, Arkansas, August 30 – September 2, 2007

What are your plans for Labor Day Weekend of this year? We truly hope you have made, or, are making plans to be in N. Little Rock, Arkansas for the **2007 Dance-A-Rama**, "Dancing on the Rock" between the dates of August 30, and September 2, of this year. The Singles Square Dancers of Arkansas Association (SSDArkA) are all working very hard to make this dance a large success and to make sure you have a great time. We have a great staff lined up for both square and round dancing and two wonderful local bands for your entertainment and dancing pleasure at the afterparties. Have you registered yet? If not, then now is the time to send in your registration form. You can get this form by visiting our website at dar2007.ssdua.org or by calling Brenda Griffin, Chairman (501-847-7851), or Bud Cude, V-Chairman (479-394-2816). We are really looking forward to your visit.

The city of N. Little Rock known only as "opposite Little Rock" until the Civil War, grew as a crossroads that linked river and overland traffic. The city of North Little Rock is located just across the river from Little Rock, which most do not distinguish apart from each other. Little Rock is the capital and the most populous city of the State of Arkansas. Located near the geographic center of Arkansas, Little Rock derives its name from a small rock formation on the south bank of the Arkansas River called La Petite Roche (the "little rock"). The "little rock" was used by early river traffic as a landmark and became a well-known river crossing. N. Little Rock and Little Rock offer exciting nightlife, vibrant downtown entertainment, a wealth of unique day trip sightseeing tours, excellent restaurants, multiple shopping and lodging choices, museums, and a one-of-a-kind attraction known as the William J. Clinton Presidential Library. Famous for being President Clinton's first capital city, the cradle of the civil rights movement, and the center of the beautiful Natural State, the two cities represent a bridge from the treasured past to the exciting 21st century. The downtown areas of N. Little Rock and Little Rock are linked by several bridges two of which are within walking distance of our host hotel the Wyndham Riverfront in N. Little Rock and our secondary hotel, The Double Tree Hotel in downtown Little Rock. There is also two-and-a-half miles of track and three bright yellow streetcars that will pick you up less than a block from the Wyndham and take you across the river to what is known as The Rivermarket area of Little Rock for dining, more dancing, and shopping.

Both cities are located between Interstate 40 and Interstate 30. The airport is only about 15 minutes from the Hotel with free shuttle service provided by both Hotels. The official airline for the 37th National Singles Dance-A-Rama is American Airlines. You can refer to our registration flyer for reservations and discount information. So whatever your mode of transportation you should have no problem getting to us. Check out what both cities have to offer at www.northlittlerock.org and www.littlerock.org for many exciting points of interest as well as restaurants and lodging. Not only does N. Little Rock and Little Rock have so much to offer we are less than an hour from the famous "Spa City", Hot Springs, known for its natural hot springs bath houses, and gorgeous lakes. We encourage everyone to register for one of the three tours offered which will take in many of the sites that have made North Little Rock, Little Rock and Hot Springs such interesting cities.

The host hotel (Wyndham Riverfront) is filling up fast. As of last count, we are already over half booked. So if you have not made your room reservation then we strongly urge you to do so now by calling the toll free number of 1-866-657-4458 or the hotel directly at 501-371-9000 to make your reservation. There has been some confusion as to the room rates. They are a flat rate of \$79.00 until the cut-off date of August 6, 2007. The Wyndham Riverfront Hotel (Host Hotel) where the dance will be held is located on the north bank of the Arkansas River just 5 minutes off Interstate 30 and less than a mile from downtown Little Rock with free on-site parking for all guests of the hotel and the Dance-A-Rama. Located in and adjacent to the hotel is the Benihana Japanese Steak House and the Riverfront Restaurant and Steak House which offers a great buffet lunch. There are several fast food eateries just minutes away. For additional information go to www.wyndham.com. Please help support us by staying at our host hotel. If you wish to stay at the Double Tree Hotel just across the river you can call the hotel directly at (501) 372-4371 or the central reservations system at 1-800-222-TREE. The room rates are \$89.00 for a single/double and \$99.00 for a triple/quadruple until the cutoff date of July 29, 2007. Please be sure to mention the Single Square Dancers USA-Dance-A-Rama in order to receive the negotiated rates when you call to register. For additional information go to www.doubletree.com.

SSDUSA at the Nationals - by Dave Hinde

Have you been to the National Square Dance Convention lately - or ever? **Why not?**

The National Square Dance Convention, or NSDC, didn't used to be the best dance for the Single or Solo dancer. Some Convention Committees put us down as an afterthought and they didn't really understand our needs. Lately, they have realized that we are a major part of the NSDC, accounting for more than 10% of the dancers in attendance. We don't want to dance in just one hall, we like to dance in the Plus Hall, the Mainstream Hall, the Advanced and Challenge Halls, and the Round Dance rooms. We like to attend the clinics, the panel discussions, & all the special events.

The committee at this year's National has been especially receptive to us. We have been asked to organize two panel discussions, and to host a "Solo Get Acquainted" dance on Thursday evening. The second of the panel discussions will be on Saturday and will be more of an open forum discussion, talking about the needs of a Single or Solo dancer. This will be your chance to speak out! The NSDC committee has also provided us with a room to hold our summer Board Meeting, on Friday.

For those that haven't attended a National before, it will be an experience like no other dance you have ever been to. There is no way to compare the NSDC to any other dance. All the callers will be volunteers, but most of the top national callers do volunteer. Callers will change every 5 to 10 minutes (one or two records) and dancing is continuous. When you want to stop, you leave the square and someone else will take your place. This year the most popular hall will probably be the mainstream hall, where you can dance to the live music of The Ghost Riders Square Dance Band.

Dancing at the National starts at 10 AM and lasts until 10 PM. From 10 PM to Midnight there are afterparties hosted by various organizations. SSDUSA will host one on Thursday, called the "Solo Get Acquainted Dance". Expect all the top callers to be at our dance, because they all love to call for us! During the day there will be panel discussions, clinics, and other educational sessions, or you can just dance for 14 hours!

There are **more single/solo dancers at the NSDC** than at any other dance in the country, including our own Single's National. Many of those dancers have never been to the SSDUSA Dance-a-Rama, and many have never heard of Single Square Dancers USA. So, how do we let them know about the fun we have at our events? We go to the National and tell them!! If you see a person with a Solo Ribbon sitting on the sidelines, ask them to dance, or help them find a partner. Mention SSDUSA and our Dance-A-Rama to everyone in your square. --- See you all in Charlotte!

3. With urging from Nasser Shukayr and others, I am in the process of implementing new pages on my website that begin with a main page of new, tried, true, and un-tried, DEAS: with Separate sections with Fantastic IDEAS concerning help and aids for the following: All Square Dance Entities; Square Dance Clubs, Established Callers, New Callers, Associations, Publications, Square Dancers, Comments, Feedback, etc.

4. Nasser Shukayr and Doug Davis have agreed to hold an International Trail-In Caller College here in Texarkana, in June, 2007. We've got 5 of the 12 signed up so far!

5. I am publicly soliciting YOUNG singers in the area (gospel, country/western, etc.), who don't now get paid for their great work, but who also don't now dance. The plan is to teach them square dance, teach them calling; brain-washing them into helping square dance by helping themselves to more mike time to hone their own craft, and possibly they can pay their expenses while they continue to learn, and maybe win the "lottery" by becoming a GREAT CALLER.....they may not stay with square dance in the long run, but we can show them a lot of fun, they will bring their PEERS with them, they'll all have fun, a lot of them will get "hooked" and we'll have a whole new world of dancers to dance with and keep this thing alive!
