43rd National Dance-A-Rama 2013
St. Louis, MO
August 29-31 – September 1, 2013

The holidays are over and it is time to start making plans for your summer dancing fun. #1 should be getting registered for the National Singles Dance A Rama. It will be at the Renaissance Airport Hotel in ST. Louis Mo.

Along with your registration and room, is the tours. Unfortunately the planned "Grants Farm Tour" that was scheduled for Thursday has been canceled. It has been replaced by a tour titled New Cathedral and Forest Park. It is featured in another article in this issue.

The two tours for Friday are: Beautiful Blooms & Historic Homes. Visit the Missouri Botanical Garden, the oldest botanical garden in the country. A guided private tram tour will wind through the 79 acres of flora from a variety of diverse climates. Visit the Climatron. The first geodesic dome greenhouse based on Buckminster Fuller's futuristic design. Next explore the real charter of St. Louis through three of the most historic neighborhoods. Compton Heights developed in the late nineteenth century by wealthy German beer barons. Lafayette Square features renovated Victorian mansions and row houses which surround Lafayette Park, the oldest public park west of the Mississippi. You will not be able to miss the 100 acre Anheuser-Busch Brewery Complex with over 70 red brick buildings. Cost \$50.00

Rivertown St. Louis: Your tour guide traces the history of St. Louis beginning with the city's original settlement, *Laclede's Landing*. It is now a nine block historic district filler with renovated buildings housing shops, eateries and offices. Next you will visit the famous Gateway Arch – the Nation's tallest monument. Here take a tram ride to the top of the 630' stainless architectural wonder. You may also visit the free Museum of Westward Expansion, located beneath the arch. Finally experience the "Mighty" Mississippi first hand during a Riverboat cruise aboard an authentic paddle wheeler for a one hour sightseeing cruise. Cost \$62.00

<u>Saturday</u> give you two more tours to choose from. **Sights of St. Louis**, and **Forest Park**, **Meet me in St. Louis**

Sights of St Louis include the Old Cathedral, the Old Courthouse, Busch Stadium and Laclede's Landing. Enjoy a view of the Old Cathedral, the oldest cathedral west of the

Mississippi. Across the street is the Old Courthouse, the setting for cases involving slavery, the fur trade and equal rights. Of the cases, the Dred Scott Freedom Trail is the most notable. Next you will visit the famous Anheuser-Busch Brewery. You will see the World Famous Clydesdales, The Fermentation Building, the packaging and Bottling Plant, the Brew House and a film about the brewing process. No visit would be complete without a stop in the hostility room to sample the family of Anheuser-Busch products. **Cost \$48.00**

Forest Park, Meet me in St. Louis: Forest Park, the site of the 1904 World's Fair, and one of the largest parks in the United States. Today, Forest park is home to the world renowned Saint Louis Zoo, The Saint Louis Art Museum, the History Museum, the Science Center and the Muny, the largest outdoor theater in the country. Enjoy a visit to the History Museum at the Jefferson Memorial. Here you can explore the history of St. Louis from 1764 to the present, including the Lewis and Clark Expedition and the early days of aviation with Charles Lindbergh's historic transatlantic flight. Next, explore the 90 acre Saint Louis Zoo. Begin the Living World, an interactive visitor and education center. Then visit the more than 3,500 residents living in their natural habitats. The motor coach will shuttle between each attraction and tour guides will give passengers a shuttle schedule. Cost \$44.00

There are many attractions to see in St Louis why not let experienced guides do all the work and enjoy the tour. If you have questions, feel free to get in touch with me and I will do my best to answer your questions.

The deadline has been extended until 15 August 2013. Tell your friends and register. Don't forget the Mystery Tour on Sunday.

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM RENNAISSANCE ST. LOUIS AIRPORT HOTEL

(HOST HOTEL FOR THE DANCE-A-RAMA 2013)

INCIDENTALS AUTHORIZATION/DEPOSIT: For guests paying for their own rooms, an incidentals deposit is collected upon check-in. Depending on the method of payment, the amounts are as follows:

<u>Credit Card</u>: \$50 per night is authorized on the credit card. Upon checkout, the unused portion of the authorization is released back to the card.

<u>Debit Card</u>: \$50 per night is held from the checking account tied to the debit card. Upon checkout, any unused funds are released back to the bank. The amount of time it takes to have access to the returned funds is up to the individual's banking institution, but it is typically within 5 working days after check-out. Please note you will not have access to these funds until your bank releases the hold. The Hotel does not have control over banking policy.

<u>Cash</u>: A **one-time** \$50 deposit is collected along with the entire amount due for the room itself. Any unused funds are returned to the guest at check-out.

CANCELLATION OF THURSDAY "THE ANHEUSER-BUSCH CONNECTION" TOUR AND REPLACEMENT BY" NEW CATHEDRAL AND FOREST PARK" TOUR

New Cathedral and Forest Park (\$42.00) Thursday, August 29, 2013, 9:00 am - 4:00 pm

This itinerary begins with a stop at the New Cathedral in Midtown, a drive through the Central West End and a Forest Park overview. Next, the motor coach will shuttle between the Saint Louis Science Center and Planetarium, the Missouri History Museum, the Saint Louis Zoo and the Saint Louis Art Museum. Although the shuttle will run between all four attractions, it is recommended guests select two attractions to visit in order to make the most of their experience.
