First, I want to apologize for the late issuance of this quarters SSDUSA'S INTERCOM. I wish I could say that the dog ate my homework but I don't have a dog! What happened is that I tripped over my feet, fell on my left hip and broke it on April 8th! As I have a high threshold of pain, I didn't know it was broken. When I finally got off the floor, I walked to my bedroom and tried to sleep - the next morning I knew I was in trouble and as I live in a high rise, I called our engineer and asked for his help. He told me to call 911 and he would bring them right up. I put on my shoes and mumu and met them at the door with my id and insurance cards. But I do plan to be at the DAR in St. Louis and a few other dances in July/August time frame to at least watch even if I can't dance!

INCIDENTALS AUTHORIZATION/DEPOSIT: For guests paying for their own rooms, an incidentals deposit is collected upon check-in. Depending on the method of payment, the amounts are as follows:

<u>Credit Card</u>: \$50 per night is authorized on the credit card. Upon checkout, the unused portion of the authorization is released back to the card.

New Cathedral and Forest Park (\$42.00) Thursday, August 29, 2013, 9:00 am - 4:00 pm

On a cold Sunday afternoon in January 1984 the officers of the Single Wheelers Square Dance Club sat around a card table and planned the 1st Annual Single Wheelers Memorial Weekend Square Dance. The whole idea came from one of the officers who had attended Dance-A-Rama in They knew many of the single dancers in Denver. Nebraska would never travel to a square dance weekend so a weekend dance was brought to Nebraska. They had the full support of Jerry Junck who was their club caller at the time. Jerry has been on the staff at all except three of the weekends. Through the years there have been over twenty different callers and cuers on the weekend staff. There were 191 dancers at the first weekend in May 1984 and the largest crowd was in 1986 with 364 dancers attending the weekend. Dancers from over 30 states plus Canada have attended. There have been a number of dancers who met at the weekend and gotten married. It would be fun to hear from some of these couples. Through the years there have been many things tried and some changed and some kept the same. The weekend has always been two full days of dancing. There has been many different after-parties held, some long with great skits, others short with skits and the callers and cuers doing the entertaining. The after-after party of food on Saturday night has been a huge hit with the first being unplanned early morning pancakes at one of the officer's home. The past several years have been the same as everyone likes it so well: chicken wings, veggies, fruit, chips and bars.
