

### **Tours**

Arlington Cemetery - 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, Wednesday, Aug 31 (\$35): Arlington National Cemetery is a living chronicle of American history and a remembrance for those who have served honorably in the United States military and in leadership of the country. Board the cemetery's interpretive tour bus, with hop-on and hop-off privileges, that takes you near the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, President John F. Kennedy Gravesite, U.S. Coast Guard Memorial, U.S. Army General Pershing Gravesite, Memorial Amphitheater, Marine Corps War Memorial, and the Arlington House (Robert E. Lee Memorial). Witness the changing of the Guard every half hour at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier which honors an unidentified soldier and is guarded 24/7 all year long. Explore the hallowed grounds on your own amongst the thousands of white headstones that are graves and memorials of others like Robert Kennedy, President William Howard Taft, the crew of the Space shuttle Challenger, Pierre L'Enfant, the architect of Washington DC, Supreme Court Justices, historical figures, explorers and a few foreign nationals. At the entrance is the Memorial to the Women in Military Service of America. Only bottled water is allowed in the cemetery. Price includes transportation, interpretive tour bus fee & gratuities.

Kennedy Center Play – 7:00 pm to 11:00 pm, Wednesday, Sep 1 (\$55): Shear Madness is the comedy whodunit that lets the audience solve the crime! Set in present-day Georgetown, Shear Madness engages locals and visitors alike as armchair detectives to help solve the scissor-stabbing murder of a famed concert pianist who lives above the Shear Madness unisex hairstyling salon. The show combines up-to-the-minute improvisational humor and a mixture of audience sleuthing to deliver a unique performance each night. Shear Madness has been running in the Kennedy Center's Theater Lab for over 28 years, giving more than 1,200 performances and is the second longest play in the history of American Theater (its sister production of Shear Madness in Boston is #1.)
