I really can't believe that it is December already! It seems like just yesterday I was putting a summer B-B-Q recipe in the column. None the less we are all going to be getting busy with the hustle and bustle of the coming holiday seasons. Here is a quick meal that will warm you up and is both nutritious and delicious.



TORTELLINI WITH ESCAROLE AND BEANS

1 bunch escarole, washed carefully and coarsely chopped - 2 tbs olive oil - 1 small onion, chopped - 1 large clove garlic, finely chopped - 1/2 cup chicken broth - 1 15oz can great northern beans, drained - 1 8oz pkg fresh cheese or meat tortellini.

1. Drop greens into boiling water, cover and bring back to a boil. Cook for 1 minute; drain.
2. Boil tortellini for 3 minutes; drain.
3. In a large skillet, heat oil; add garlic and onion. Cook over low heat for 2 minutes. .
4. Add escarole, beans, chicken broth and tortellini; cover and simmer over low heat for 8 minutes.
5. Serve with warm, crusty Italian or French bread to soak up the tasty juices.

Are we overlooking the most important member in your square dance club? No, it's neither the caller nor the cuer, as good as they may be. It isn't the president of your club; not any of the officers either - even though they may be dedicated and efficient. So who does that leave? The NEWCOMER!

They are the most recent new additions to your roster. They may be a recent graduate, a transfer from another club or from many different possibilities.

We must make the NEWCOMER feel welcome. Are they being greeted sincerely? Are they being invited into your square or do you ignore them? Do you invite them to attend a dance, a weekend or another activity?

It doesn't take long for the NEWCOMER to feel they are unwanted and that they don't fit into the club. They soon stop coming and who offers a friendly call asking why? Soon another potential, active member is lost!

Without question clubs must admit that NEWCOMERS don't need us, the regular members - we NEED them if our clubs are going to survive!

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Dear Editors:

Time for someone again to point out some serious omissions from many square dance flyers.

The November Promenader carried ads for six dances. Not one of them included all the information I look for in an ad.

The year should be listed in every ad, so that one knows if the flyer is six months out of date or six months in advance of the dance. Maybe you know when you make the flyer, but I have seen flyers where either one could have been the case.

The day of the week should be listed in every ad. Your flyer will just be discarded and wasted if your dance turns out to be on a day of the week that is already busy for the one who picks it up. Most people don't know more than a few weeks ahead whether a certain date will come on one of their free days.

Your ad should also name the city, town or suburb where your hall is located, and the state, in case it travels outside your own local area. Saying just "Fire Hall" or "Methodist Church" is not nearly specific enough to a stranger!

Most people remember to include the price, the caller and cuer, the dance program (class, plus, advance, whatever), time and a phone number for information, but a checkoff list for yourself to use when you make each flyer is a very helpful tool.

Your original flyer has lots of space - be sure it has the needed information as well as the sales pitch!

News from the Editors about the "SILVER CLUB".

Starting in January, the Silver Club will be active again. This is sponsored by your Federation. Elaine and I have been working on this project and plans are in place to have the books available in January to be handed out at the Jan. meeting and then distributed to your clubs by your representatives.

The rules have changed a bit and they will be printed on the inside cover of the book. The goal of the Silver Club is to get dancers out to dance to other clubs. One book for each dancer. Dangles will be available through the Federation.

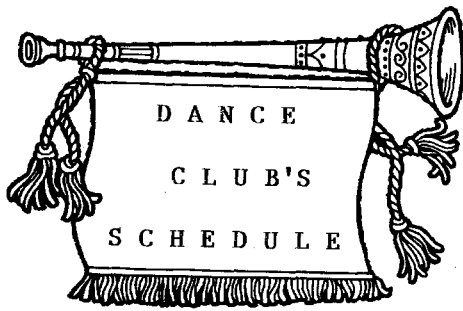
Here are the new rules:

- 1) Dance to the Calling and/or Cueing of 25 eligible callers/cuers. Get their Signature with the DATE and CLUB in the spaces provided.
- 2) At least 15 of 25 names MUST be affiliated with the Federation Clubs or Caller's Cooperative of Rochester. A list of eligible Callers and Cuers are listed inside the back cover.
- 3) A maximum of 10 names that are not on the eligible list, can be used as long as they are calling or cueing at one of the Federation Affiliated Clubs, or at Dance-O-Rama.
- 4) The same caller or cuer may be used more than once, as long as they are calling/cueing at a different Federation Club.
- 5) With callers/cuers that make up a group, the group name may be used only once for an event and the individual caller/cuer may not be used for the same event.
- 6) When you have the required number of signatures, show this booklet to the Federation President or their representative, who will verify the names and authorize you to wear the special Silver Club Badge Dangle.
- 7) There is no grandfather clause: everyone starts out even. All signatures must be dated no earlier the January, 1996.

These rules were adopted by the Federation and we all hope they are not too confusing. If you have questions about these or need more definition, please call anyone of the Federation Board Members or us and we will do our best to clarify.

We tried to use the KISS method and we hope you will also try and keep it light and have fun with the Silver Club and go out and dance with as many other clubs as possible.

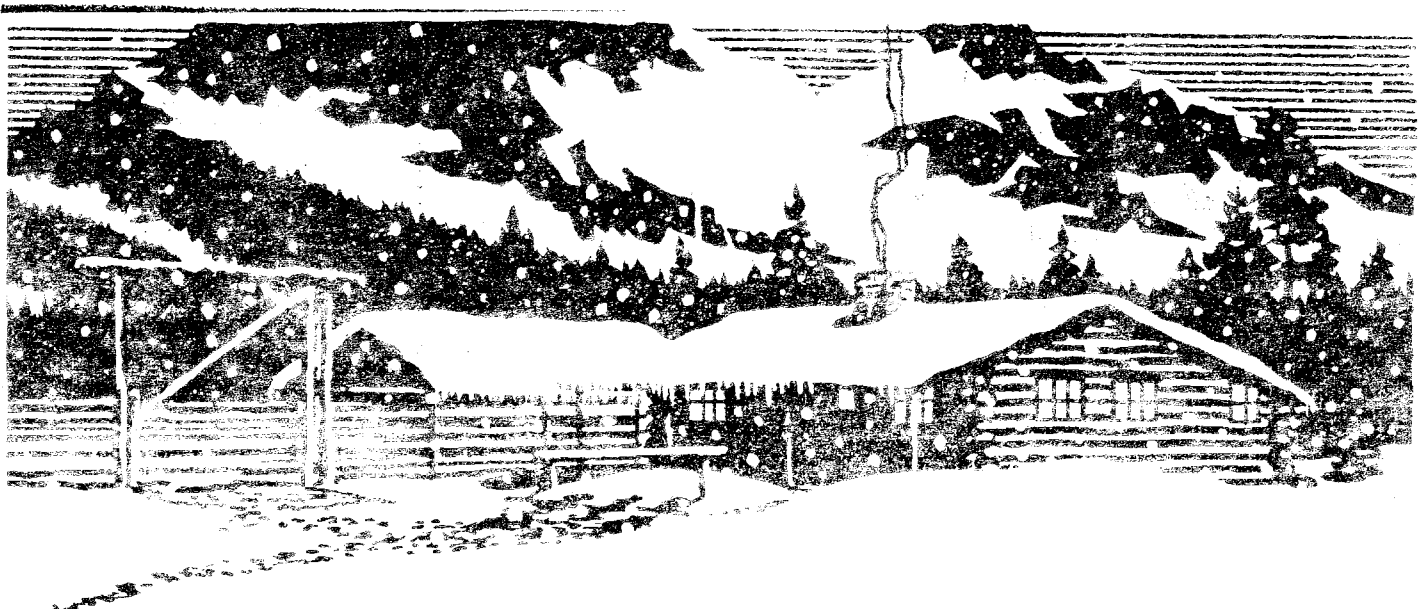

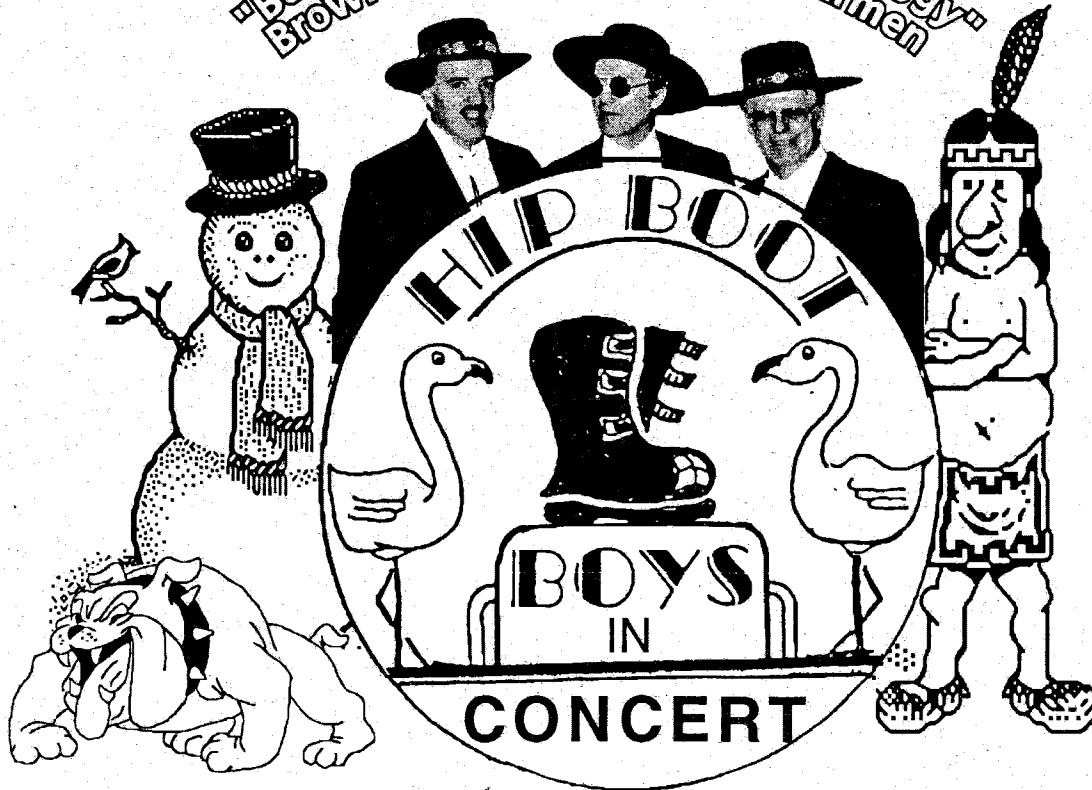
