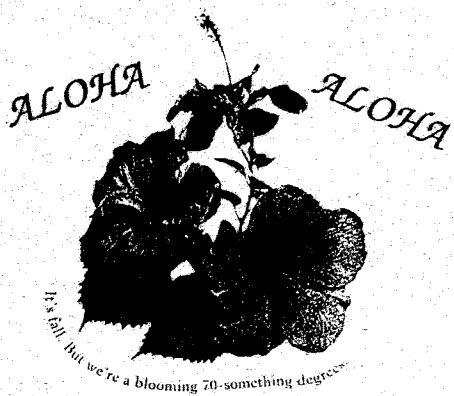

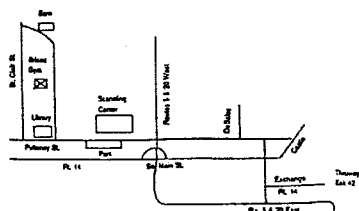

Well here it is, the summer issue. I'll miss getting the recipes to you for the next couple of months. I did want to give you all (y'all) a Cajun recipe for this issue, but I decided that an appetizer would be more useful through the summer for picnics, barbecues, pool parties and the like. This recipe does have a touch of Cajun because of the hot sauce ingredient, make it as hot or as mild as you choose, but make it often throughout the summer.



### CRABBY MUSHROOMS

1 cup crabmeat - 1 tbsp bread crumbs - 1 tbsp minced onions - 1 tbsp parmesan cheese, grated - 1 tsp salt - 2 tbsp minced parsley - 12 mushroom stems, chopped fine - 12 mushroom caps - 1 egg, beaten - Louisiana hot sauce to taste.

In a bowl, mix crabmeat, bread crumbs, onions, cheese, salt, parsley, and chopped mushroom stems. Add beaten egg and hot sauce, to taste, stuff mixture into mushroom caps. Bake at 300F until tender, 15 to 30 minutes. Serve hot.

NOTE: This recipe multiplies very well depending on the number of people you are serving.

### WHERE ARE THE NEW DANCERS GOING?

As we end up our dance seasons we need to ask this very important question. If your club was lucky enough to have a class, where do the new dancers dance? Most clubs lower the level after graduation and this allows the new dancers to "join the club". But what happens to them after the season ends? If they do not attend a summer workshop for Plus, after attending class for 28 or 29 weeks, where do they go in September? The answer is nowhere. We as a dance community do not give the new mainstream dancers a place to hone their newly acquired skills. We do not give them the opportunity to enjoy the activity as they have learned it. If they really want to dance or "join the club" they must be forced to go through a summer to learn plus. Is this fair? There is a very low success rate for those who try, or have the time over the summer to attend a workshop of plus. Callerlab recommends that dancers dance at each level one year before moving up to the next level. This does two very important things, 1) it gives them time to practice and enjoy what they learned. 2) it lets them get comfortable dancing. If we continue to force new grads to do plus we will keep our

retention of new dancers down. We can't afford to do this. The old saying is if it isn't broke, don't fix it. Well Square Dancing is on the verge of being broke and we need to find ways to fix it now! We welcome your thoughts and help to stop the downward spiral on Square Dancing! We need to work as a Square Dance Community to start our growth once again. Have a great summer, see you in the fall.

### LETTER TO THE EDITOR

We at Genesee Dancers have been trying to decide the best way to celebrate our 40th Anniversary Year; and what better way than to focus on rejuvenating our club. We all know our clubs have been getting smaller and attendance faltering; at the same time, people are tiring of electronic gadgets, looking for ways to do "real life" fun things.

What better way than to get into square dancing? How to attract new members? We need to extend a verbal personal invitation to people who are likely to be interested; such as, your own church groups. The key is full respect and courtesy for everyone. Anyone who has flown on a major airline recently knows that every employee, from the pilots to the cabin attendants zero in on every courtesy to the passengers. The widespread viewpoint of the past in square dancing in which some experienced dancers tended to have "superiority attitudes" must be done away with. The new dancers must be helped in every way: our belief is, that the current level and amount of total calls used at the present time (which is a consolidation of what used to be known as mainstream and plus calls) can be successfully taught from scratch over a period of 30 one hour lessons. (An immediate class/club tip following the lesson would help them gain confidence.) We want the new couples to be able to join the regular dancing ASAP and not give up, as so many new dancers have in the past.

So, here's to a new life, and future in square dancing! All of us need to realize the absolute need for this fresh outlook.

## LEADERSHIP AWARD BACKGROUND

The Leadership Award was established in 1977 by Frank Salvagio and John Fink in honor of their wives, Norma and Daphne. The purpose of the award is to show appreciation for EXTENSIVE AND SUSTAINED LEADERSHIP OVER AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF YEARS in square, round, or contra dancing. Leadership, service, and motivation are considered when evaluating candidates for this award. A candidate need not demonstrate leadership in all areas, nor is each area given equal consideration. Areas of leadership may include, but are not limited to, years of dancing or calling, membership, committee service, or officer role in any of the following: Square, Round or Contra Club, Rochester Area Federation; Promenader, Dance-O-Rama, NYS Association or National Associations, promoting the activity through calling or teaching, and other leadership roles which benefit the community through the square dance activity. Finally, consideration is given to the candidate's attitude and continuing willingness to take on responsibilities in the square dance community.

An individual or couple may win the award only once. The award may not be given if the Selection Committee unanimously agrees no one met the criteria.

Anyone in the square dance community is welcome to nominate people for the Leadership Award. The Rochester area is blessed with many fine leaders and it would be helpful to those on the Selection Committee to receive input from the square dance community.

## "IS ADVANCED DANCING FOR ME?"

After varying periods in the Plus program dancers sometimes ponder this question. Here are some (our) thoughts on the subject. (Obviously this column is directed toward non-members.)

## Finger Lakes Squares
