#### SPINACH TORTELLINI SOUP

- 1 small onion chopped
- 5 cups chicken broth
- 2 carrots, peeled and thinly sliced (about 1

1 pkg. (8 oz.) of cheese or meat tortellini 1/2 of a 10 oz. pkg. of fresh spinach, washed, trimmed and coarsely chopped.

Combine onion, carrots, and broth; bring to a boil. Add tortellini, reduce heat and simmer 4 minutes. Add spinach and simmer 4 minutes longer, until carrots are tender. Serve with warm Italian or French bread.


#### This-n-That from the Editor's Desk...
