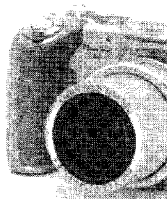

It was the year of Square Dancing and a Square thing to do in 1973. Why not in 2009?

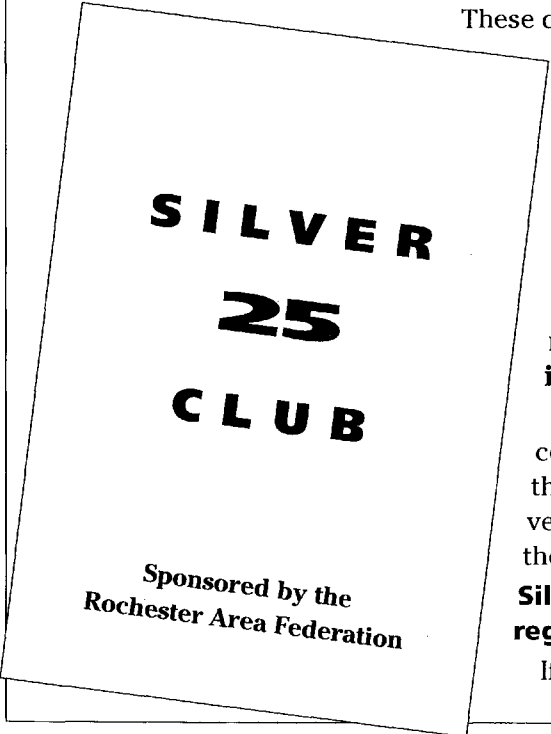

# Silver Club Booklets

The **Silver Club** is a way of recognizing dancers who have danced to 25 callers/cuers at club dances.



These dancers receive the Silver Club badge dangle.

At least 15 of the 25 caller/cuer signatures must be gotten at dances of clubs affiliated with the Rochester Area Federation of Round and Square Dance Clubs. A maximum of 10 callers/cuers at non-affiliated clubs may be included. Dance-O-Rama callers/cuers may also be included.

**The same caller or cuer may be used more than once, as long as they are calling/cueing at a different club.**

When the required number of signatures are collected in a Silver Club booklet, it is shown to the Federation presidents or their reps, who will verify the names and authorize the dancer to wear the special Silver Club badge dangle.

**Silver Club booklets will be available at D.O.R. Just ask at the registration table.**

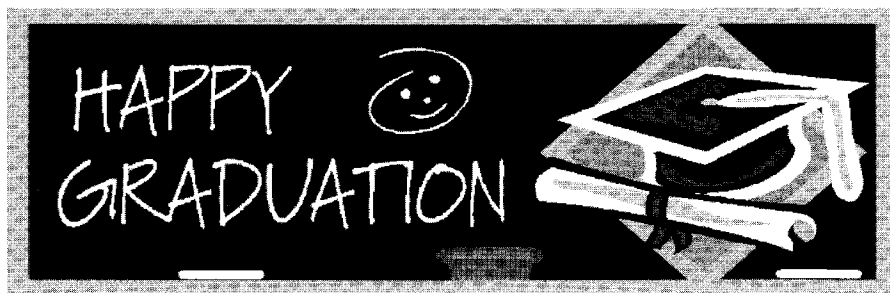

### From the South

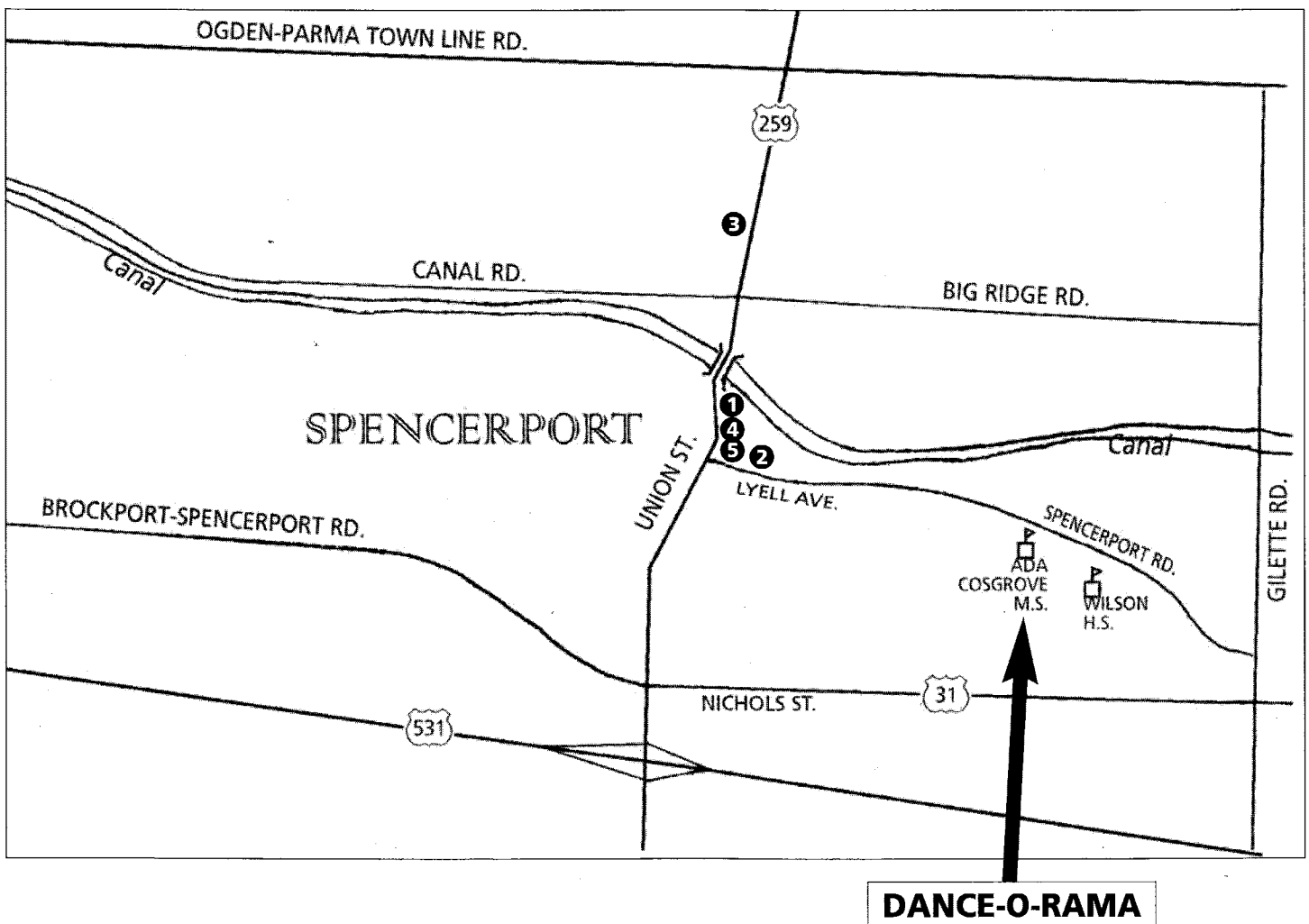
Take 390-N to Exit 20B on the left to merge onto 490 W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

### From the West

Take 490-E toward Leroy/Rochester; Take Exit 7B to merge onto Rt-531 W toward Spencerport/Brockport; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

### From the East

Take 490-W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

## In Memoriam Jane Avery – 1/16/09

A square dancer for at least 20 years, Jane, with husband Vernon, joined a Silver Squares class in 1986, under the tutelage of Mike Callahan. They also danced with Swinging Eights, a now defunct Irondequoit club. During square dancing's heyday, Jane and Vern travelled out of state to dance in such faraway places as Amarillo, Texas, and north into Canada. A very tiny lady, Jane made a lot of her own dance clothes, with matching shirts for Vern. When she bought ready-made skirts, they always had to be shortened.

Jane and Vern continued to dance together at Silver Squares until 1994, when Vern suffered a fatal stroke while golfing. After a period of mourning, Jane returned to Silver Squares, dancing with the club at the Greece Community Center and at Redmen's Club, when Silver Squares moved there in 1995. In 1999 the Redmen's Club sold their building, forcing Silver Squares to relocate. After a week of mostly fruitless phone calls, a life-saving call came from Jane. She and her husband had been members of the Ira Jacobson American Legion Post in Charlotte, where Jane at one time served as Auxiliary president. She called to advise that she had received permission for Silver Squares to dance at the Post. Jane continued to dance with us there until she broke her foot and, no longer able to dance, in 2006 moved to Fleming Point, a senior living center.

Jane claimed one chair at the Post as her own. When she was gone, we still looked for Jane in that chair.

## In Memoriam Alice Fegan – 1/22/09

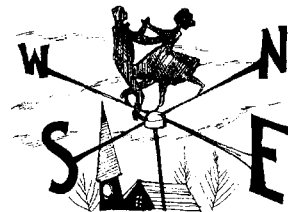

Something now seems missing from the picture without Alice's presence every Monday.

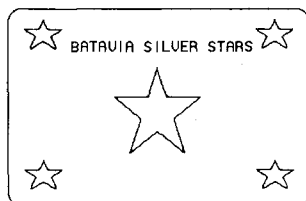

The Dalton Gang is sad to report the sudden death of Arliss Ransom on Jan. 15, 2009. Arliss and his wife, Mary, were charter members



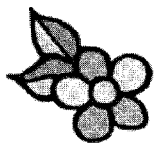
