Adopt-A-Trail on the Erie Canal



Last year, an article in a local paper prompted me to make a call and offer the services of Cloverleaf Square dance club to adopt a section of the Erie Canal. This Adopt-A-Trail program has been ongoing for 10 years, but one of the groups had withdrawn, leaving a section of the canal open for "adoption."



The section of the canal that Cloverleafs adopted runs west from the Sweden-Walker Road bridge in the town of Sweden about one mile. The volunteer task is to collect litter from the trail at least once a month during the canal season, May through October, and join in "canal sweeps" near the beginning and end of the season. Signs on the

canal path credit the individual groups. Volunteers receive hats and tee shirts with Canal System logos. The "canal sweeps" at the beginning of the season are a jump start to the program and the "canal sweeps" at the end of the season are a thank you for a job well done. Both events are accompanied by refreshments and a photo shoot for the local paper.

The idea was well received by Cloverleaf dancers and in the spring of 2010 we began our monthly litter collecting. We meet at various times according to the weather and availability of daylight. With trash bags in hand, we set off



to see what we can find. Our section is interesting because we park in an area that is a popular fishing spot and it is amazing to see what kind of things those fishermen leave behind. After picking up the parking area, we cross over the bridge and begin our one-mile walk down to our designated spot and a one-mile walk back.

During this time, we get wonderful exercise, have excellent conversations, and feel good about doing something positive for the environment. This project has been a lot of fun for us and a great feeling when we see what we have collected after our walk. And, of course, no gathering of Square Dancers goes without eating. We usually go out for lunch or ice cream after our walk and continue our conversations and friendship.
