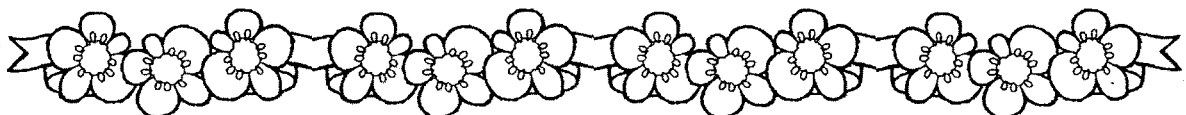

Meet Barb Green, the "Go-To Person"

When you really need a job done, I have discovered that Barb Green is the "Go-To" person! Be it getting someone to take over the Basket Raffle at DOR, or just taking care of the stuff, like that big coffee pot that always has to go home with someone after Federation Meetings...and be there early for the next meeting. Oh yes, and I should add, there is a big box of other stuff too!

Of course, I am referring to our immediate Past Co-President...who avoided the "Lime Light" during her two-year tenure, and yet did all the things, like writing the President's Corner articles for the *Promenader* and similar behind-the-scenes tasks that make us the best square dancing area, year around, in the United States!

Barb's military career began when she graduated from Niagara University School of Nursing in 1972, at which time she received a commission in the Army Nurse Corp. As an Army Nurse, she has been stationed at Walter Reed Hospital (DC), Tripler Army Hospital (Honolulu) twice; Ft. Gordon, GA; Ft. Lewis, WA, Ft Sill, OK; US Army Military Academy (West Point); Ft. Drum, NY. The Army also sent her to Baylor Univ. for a Master's in Hospital Administration. She retired in 1998 as a full Colonel, and returned to the Rochester area to live in 2000.



Since her return to Rochester, Barb has worked for the VA at the VA Hospital in Canandaigua and the Westfall Road Outpatient Clinic, and for Highland Hospital. She now works as a Utilization Management Coordinator at Strong Hospital.

Barb has been active in her church wherever she went (currently Church of the Assumption in Fairport), doing volunteer work for the Red Cross (last serving in New Orleans after Katrina), American Legion (past post commander of the Florence Nightingale Post), Military Officers Association (past president of the Genesee Valley Chapter). She also sings, and has sung in many church choirs, and most recently was a member of GVOC — Genesee Valley Orchestra and Chorus.

Other avocations include skiing, sailing (she owns a 28-ft. sailboat) and scuba diving (when she's near warmer water.) She also took flying lessons a while back, but stopped just short of getting her pilot's license when she got transferred.

When we get back in town, I am going to have to ask her how our square dancing community lucked out getting a person like her. Hope you make it a point to ask her too, and in the process, thank her for all she does for us; and has done for our country.

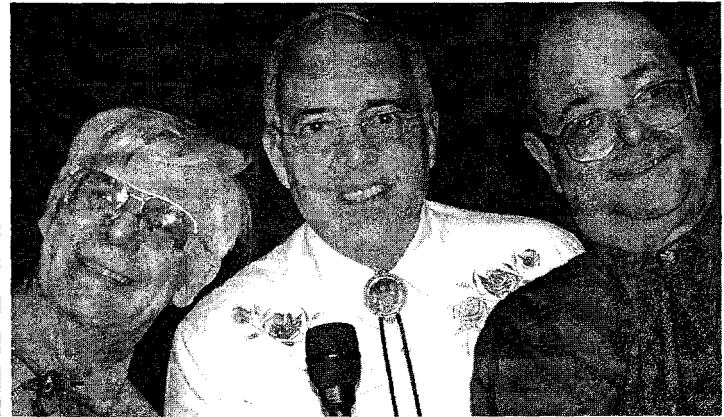
It is people like Barb that not only make square dancing fun; in Rochester, like all of our service members, she has done much to make it possible.

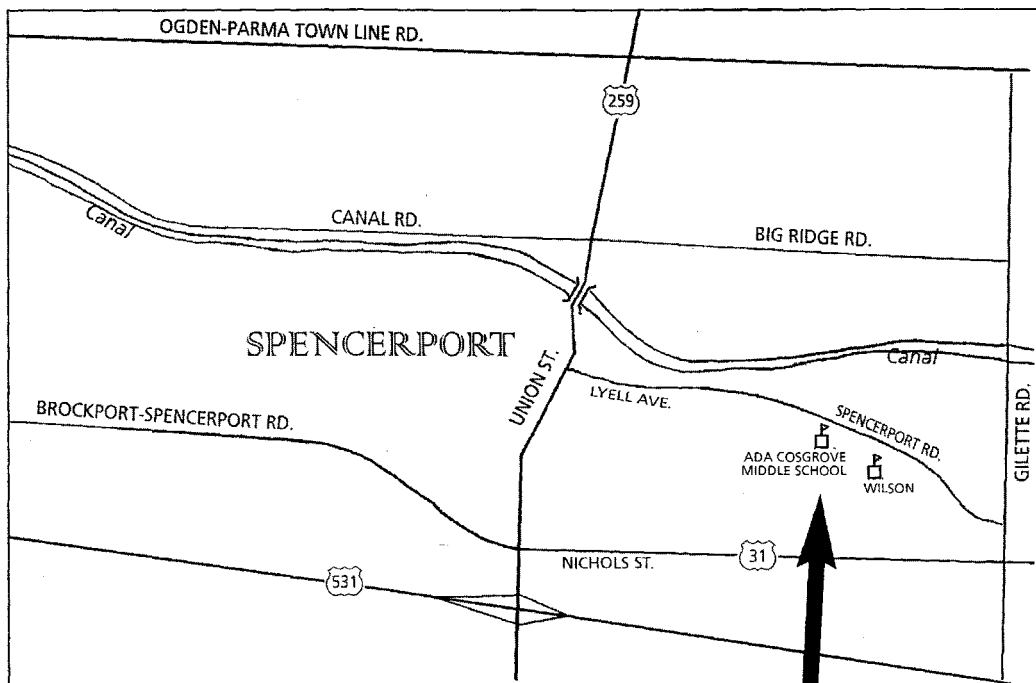

From the South

Take 390-N to Exit 20B on the left to merge onto 490 W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

From the West

Take 490-E toward Leroy/Rochester; Take Exit 7B to merge onto Rt-531 W toward Spencerport/Brockport; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed

on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

From the East

Take 490-W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of

Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

Silver Club Booklets

The **Silver Club** is a way of recognizing dancers who have danced to 25 callers/cuers at club dances.

These dancers receive the Silver Club badge dangle.

At least 15 of the 25 caller/cuer signatures must be gotten at dances of clubs affiliated with the Rochester Area Federation of Round and Square Dance Clubs. A maximum of 10 callers/cuers at non-affiliated clubs may be included. Dance-O-Rama callers/cuers may also be included.

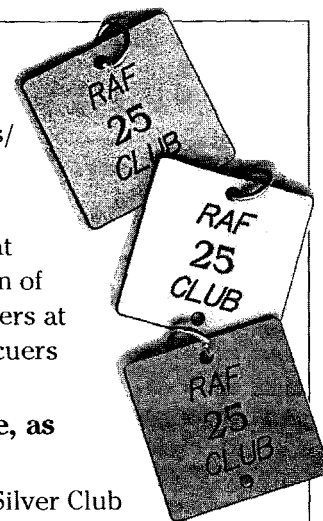
The same caller or cuer may be used more than once, as long as they are calling/cueing at a different club.

When the required number of signatures are collected in a Silver Club booklet, it is shown to the Federation presidents or their reps, who will verify the names and authorize the dancer to wear the special Silver Club badge dangle. **Silver Club booklets will be available at D.O.R. Just ask at the registration table.**
