## Raving Reparters... "History Detectives," DOR, \& the Rochester Area Federation

Wow! Just a month until we celebrate our 55th Annual "Dance-O-Rama"! Certainly our "Coming Out Party" for all of our new graduates, but so much more: the Daphne Norma Leadership Award Presentation; a Pig Roast (thanks again to our Past-Presidents Lou \& Gail Trabalzi); a great collection of callers and cuers; our Basket Raffle; Claudia's Western Shop...but, above all else, just a great chance to get together in an extraordinary time to all dance together...and, did you know that is how it all started back in 1959? Read on!

There was no Rochester area Federation at the time; however, there were a number of square dance clubs, and when Anna Marie and Frank Cady got a group together to discuss having a day-long square dance event with enthusiastic members of several clubs, notably The Belles ' $N$ ' Beaus, The Swinging Eights, and the Teen Twirlers, the first "DOR" was held on the 18th of April, 1959. It is recorded that the Teen Twirlers put on quite a show, and that McCurdy's did a Fashion Show.

It is also noteworthy that this cooperative effort, which
resulted in the first DOR, also became the genesis of the Rochester Area Federation...but that is another story.

In 1960 the tradition grew with the addition of a featured caller, Gloria Rios, in addition to the local caller staff. Again, the Teen Twirlers wowed the dancers with a pageant of historic and folk dances. The chairmen that year also grew the sponsoring clubs to include the Country Twirlers, the Fiddle-A-Rounds, the Irondequoit Squares, and the Rochester Rollaways.

And so it grew; in 1961 the list of sponsoring clubs included the Tumbleweeds; then in 1962 with Phil and Irene Warner at the helm, the EKC-O Squares joined the sponsors (and benefactors of the ever increasing gate receipts), as two big name callers were added to the local staff. By 1964 the venue had to be moved from the Cutler Union to the Recreation Building at Kodak Park as attendance blossomed from 1100 to 1500 ! Small wonder the Lima Grand Squares, the Boots 'n Slippers, and the Triggers also joined.

It is fun looking through the flyers for these super dances, in some instances with as many as four featured callers... and of course, very large gates to make that many profitable and necessary. I hope to have as many as I can of these on display at DOR. See You there.

## From the South

Take $390-\mathrm{N}$ to Exit 20 B on the left to merge onto 490 W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

## From the West

Take 490-E toward
Leroy/Rochester; Take Exit 7B to merge onto Rt-531 W toward Spencerport/Brockport; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed

on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

## From the East

Take 490 -W toward Buffalo; Take right exit toward Spencerport/Brockport onto Rt-531 W; Then take the Rt. 259/Union St. (Spencerport) exit, turn right at end of exit ramp and proceed on Rt. 259 past the Rt. 31 intersection toward the Village of

Spencerport (about a mile); Before the railroad overhead bridge, turn right onto Lyell Avenue (see DOR sign); Proceed about a mile until you see the DOR sign for the driveway to the parking lot.

## Silver Club Booklets

The Silver Club is a way of recognizing dancers who have danced to 25 callers/ cuers at club dances.
These dancers receive the Silver Club badge dangle. At least 15 of the 25 caller/cuer signatures must be gotten at dances of clubs affiliated with the Rochester Area Federation of Round and Square Dance Clubs. A maximum of 10 callers/cuers at non-affiliated clubs may be included. Dance-O-Rama callers/cuers may also be included.
The same caller or cuer may be used more than once, as CLUB long as they are calling/cueing at a different club.

When the required number of signatures are collected in a Silver Club booklet, it is shown to the Federation presidents or their reps, who will ver-

I started square dancing in 1975 at age 12. We had just moved to Laramie, Wyoming the summer of ' 75 and got started square dancing right away. My parents had danced a year before that (in Colorado) and didn't really like it. They gave it another shot when coming to Laramie and met the nicest people. At the time they had a kids club and I and my 4 siblings were invited to come learn to dance. The kids club was very active and we went dancing all over the state and into Colorado. Some of my best friends in the world are from that group of kids!

I first called a singing call in the spring of 1976 at an amateur callers night. My brother who is 4 years older than me (Brian) got very interested in calling and could pursue it more. I was "too young" ... He started getting bookings and asked me to learn to cue to go with him. So, I truly started cueing (for hire) first. And on those dances, we usually shared a tip. While he took it seriously, I didn't think I was very good, but was in it for the fun.

While in college, I started calling a monthly dance with the guy who taught me to dance (Don Hanson). That dance was not just squares, but rounds, lines, hoedown, etc. This gig lasted from about ' 82 until we moved to Aurora, CO in ' 90 . Before moving to CO I also called a dance or two with Brian and some guest calling spots in Casper. My first "big" dance was in Casper where I called and cued. I remember we had a great turnout and I got a $\$ 100$ and used the money to put a drop ceiling in my boys bedroom. Lenore and I also cued and taught round dancing for two years in Laramie before moving to Colorado.
