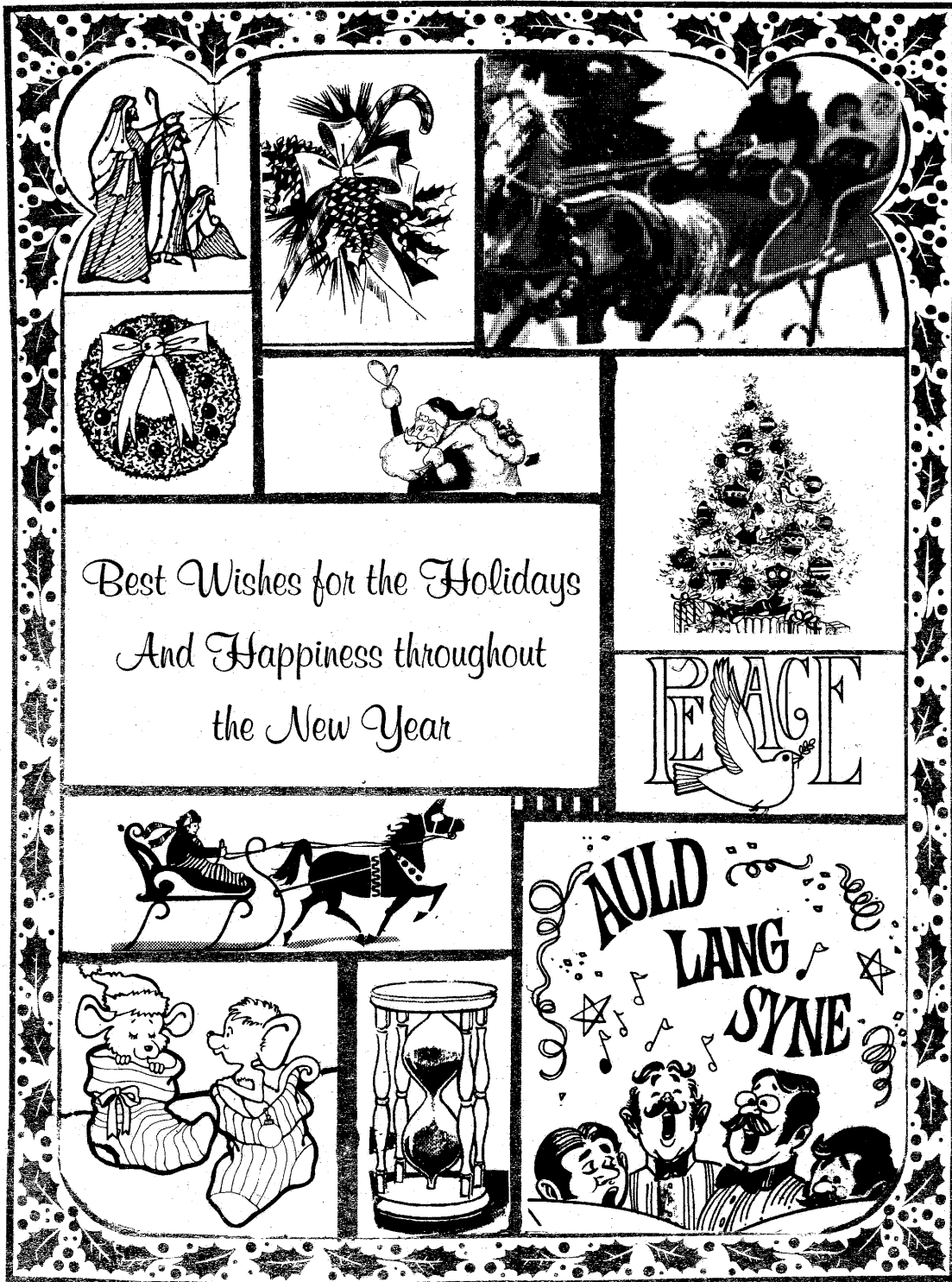

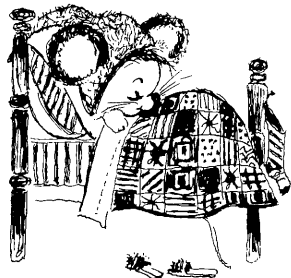

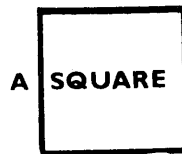
Want a ruffle on the bottom of your skirt? Cut 6 widths of fabric (or a six yard strip) six to ten inches wide (depending on how wide you want the ruffle). Sew all pieces together and

hem both edges. Put two rows of gathering stitch in and pin on top of skirt edge evenly. Pull, gathering to fit. This also can be put on like a regular tier with no top ruffle.

Whether it's a circle, gored or gathered skirt, this is a nice addition and also a good way to lengthen a short skirt or dress.

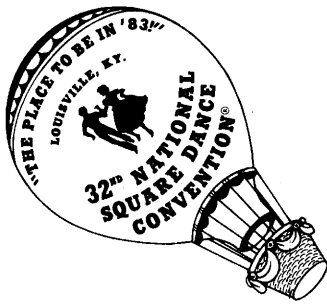

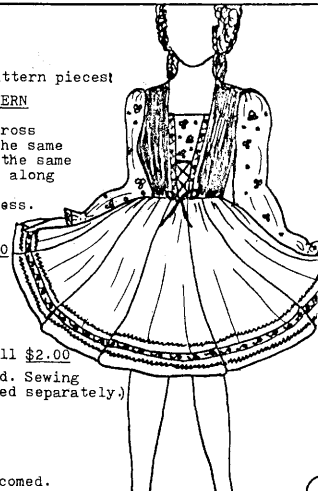

## Letter to the Editor:

It's not too early to start thinking about the 1983 graduates. One of four things will happen when new grads are uncomfortable with the level of the club into which they have graduated.

1. The caller does not drop the club's level and the new dancers cause square break-downs.

2. The caller drops the club's level and the experienced dancers have todance below their capability.

3. The new dancers leave the club and join one with a lower level.

4. The new dancers quit square dancing altogether.

All four alternatives are unacceptable. Our Federation in conjunction with Caller's Co-op (CCR) should make certain that both summer and fall workshops are available, every year, to bring the new graduates up to the dancing level of the average Rochester club.

Further, every class instructor should strongly recommend attendance at these "post-graduate" workshops, telling their students that they will probably be uncomfortable at most clubs and weekends, unless they get this additional training.

What is being advocated here is not a "mainstream plus" workshop, but, simply, sessions to strengthen the dancer's reflexes and understanding of the calls on the mainstream list. Too many clubs in the Monroe County area are misleading beginning dancers by telling these people that all they need is 30 weeks of classes to dance at any mainstream square dancing event. A workshop is critically needed, especially when the new dancer has not danced all summer.

If there is any doubt as to the validity of these concerns, the Federation should take a survey of the 1982 graduates and determine the exact degree of satisfaction that new dancers have with respect to the Rochester square dancing community. Further, the Federation and CCR should take specific action to gauge accurately the demand for more frequent offerings of workshops for the higher levels of dancing. Without organized research, too many workshops may be offered where there is little or no demand, and, conversely, no workshops may be available for dancing levels where there is great demand. It's a big tease for dancers coming to Dance-0-Rama to see many levels of dancing, but have no open classes applicable to these levels.

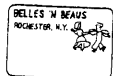

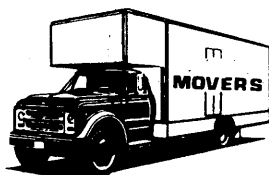
Mark February 12th on your calendar for our Valentine Dance for all classes and clubs. Dancing will be with Mike Callahan.

## HOW TO BE AN ANGEL

by Jerry Carmen

Now that beginners' classes are underway, some of you will be asked to come and help out an evening or two. Club members who attend the class session to do this are called "angels". To really be helpful, a few simple guidelines should be remembered.

1. First and foremost, the primary reason you are there is to fill in squares so none of the class has to sit out. You are not there to teach. That is the purpose of the instructor.

2. Don't be an assistant instructor. Trying to explain a call while the square is in progress is discourteous to the caller as well as confusing to the beginner who is trying to listen to both. If you must explain something, make a mental note and wait until the tip is over. Better yet, ask the instructor. After all, that's what he is there for.

3. Avoid fancy flourishes, twirls, and incorrect styling such as a waist swing for a do-sa-do. These only tend to confuse and throw others off balance. Execute each call precisely as the caller has taught and leave the fancy stuff for your friends at a club dance. What is being gained if the caller teaches it one way and you dance it another?

4. Do not talk while dancing or the caller is instructing This cannot be overemphasized and refers to people on the sidelines as well. The new dancer has all he can do to concentrate on all the new calls he is learning and asked to recall instantly. Your conversation is distracting even though you are talking to someone else.

5. Do not guide, push, or shove people into position. Do your part to demonstrate correct styling and positioning. Give a reassuring smile and dance boldly and confidently, but LET THE BEGINNER MAKE HIS OWN MISTAKES. This is very important because it will show the instructor the call has not been fully learned and needs more practice. One has not learned a call unless he can do it without help from others. Class time is the time to make mistakes, then review and practice. Getting through a tip without breaking down is not the objective of a class. A dancer pushed through a call is not learning. Just do your part in the class and save your helpfulness for a class-club dance where the "helping-hand" is really appreciated.

You have probably heard of callers who do not like to have angels at their class. This is only because of some inconsiderate people who interfere with the class progress. However, I do not know of a single caller who would not welcome you if you follow these guidelines.

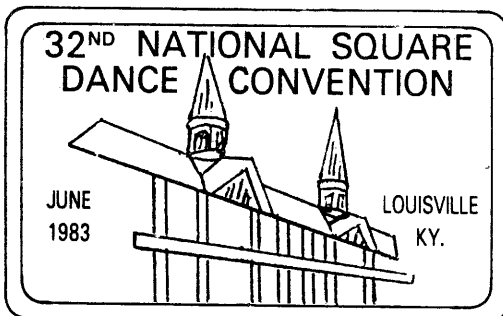

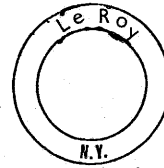
