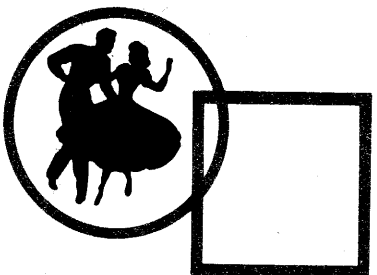

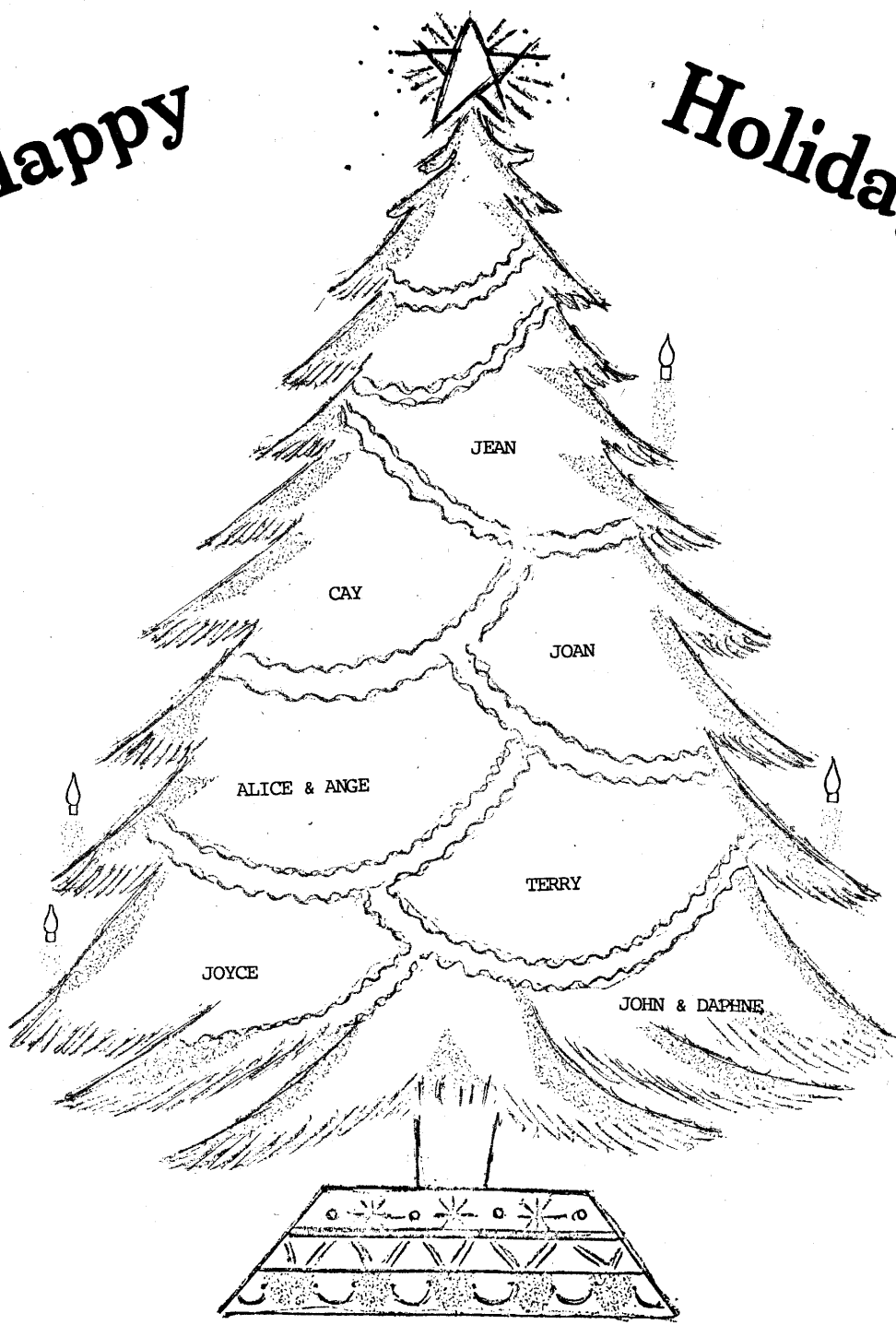

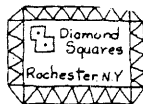
Cloverleaf Squares

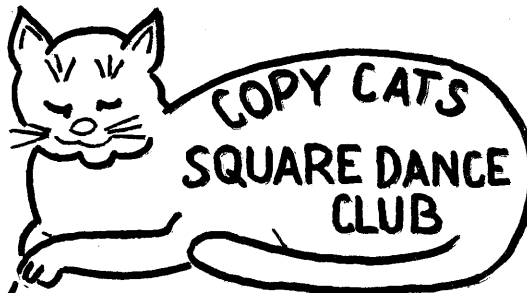
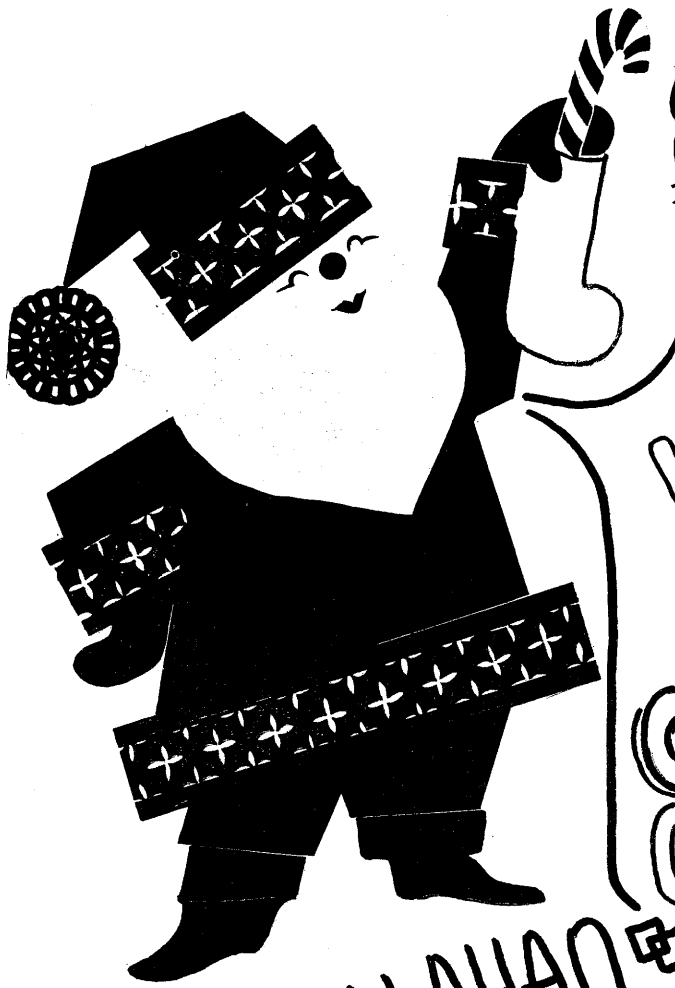
Country Dancers
