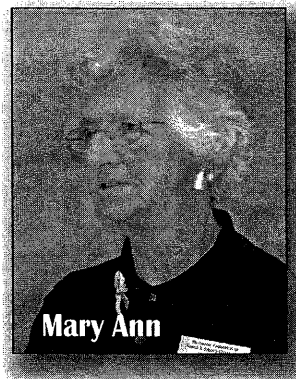


Meet Your Federation Treasurer, Mary Ann Lane

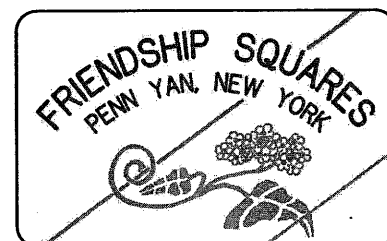


If you don't want to go to a "fed" meeting to find her, check out the Village Squares. As a long-time member, she does not hide her many talents under a bushel there either.
