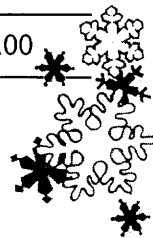

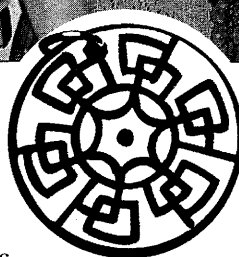

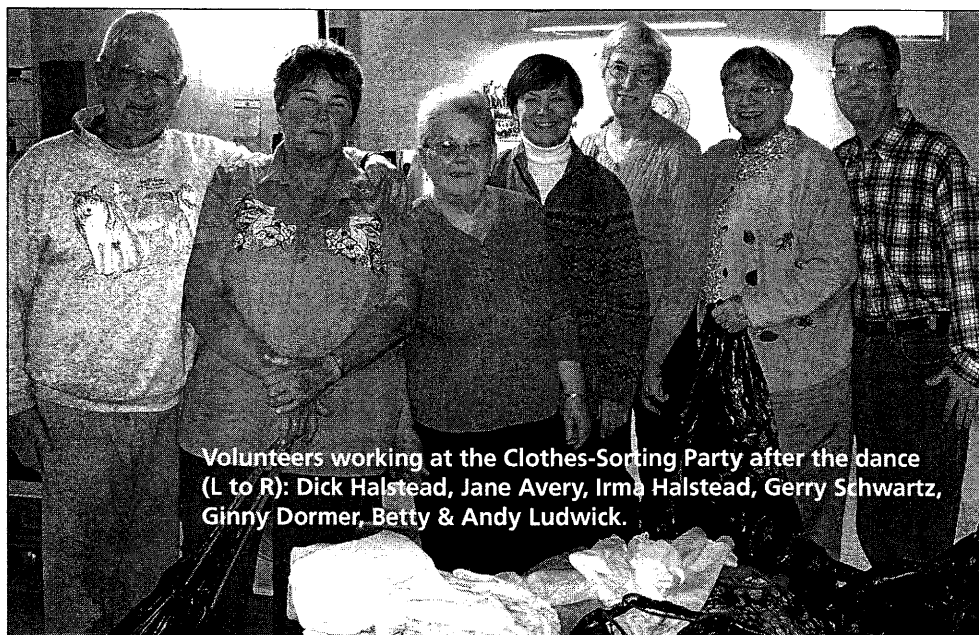
road, we hope one or more of our staff will have the confidence and experience to finally take over our current position of general editors.

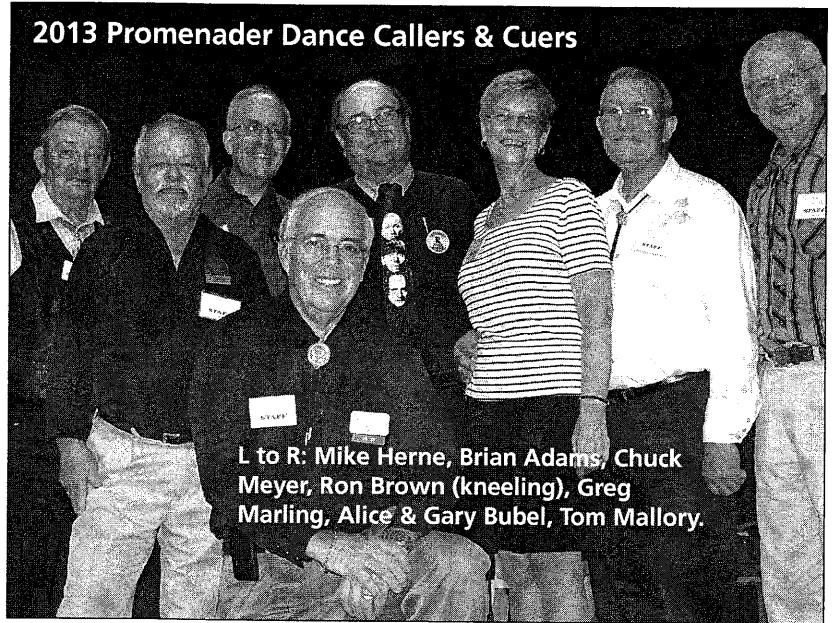
Thanks go out especially to our great callers and cuers that do so much for us, year in and year out.

Cayuga Cut Ups

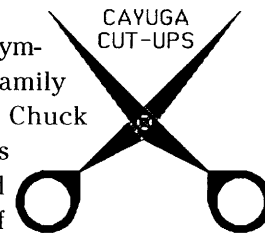

Climate

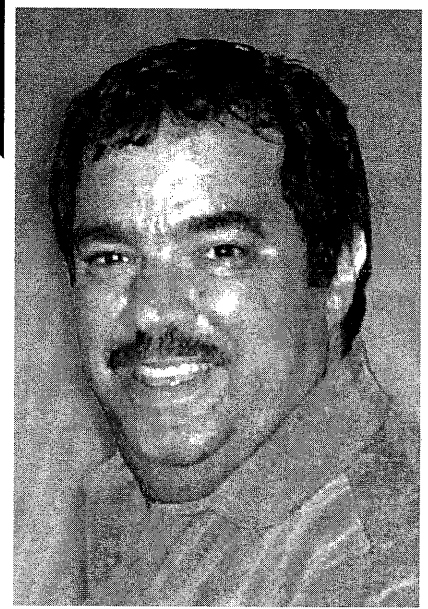

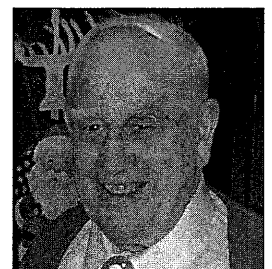
The "Wednesday Guys," a church work group Brad

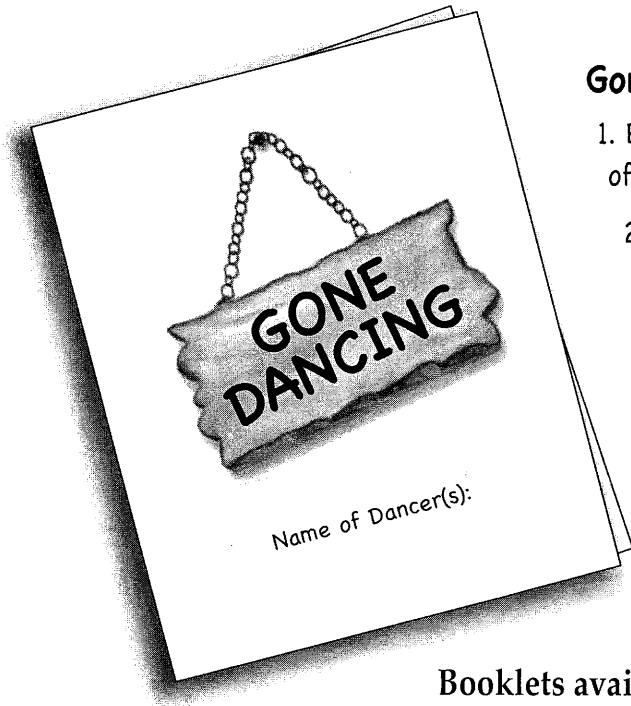
It is now our time to remember Barb with our on-going love and actions. For Brad, we pray God Speed to that, "Pearl of Great Price." Amen.
