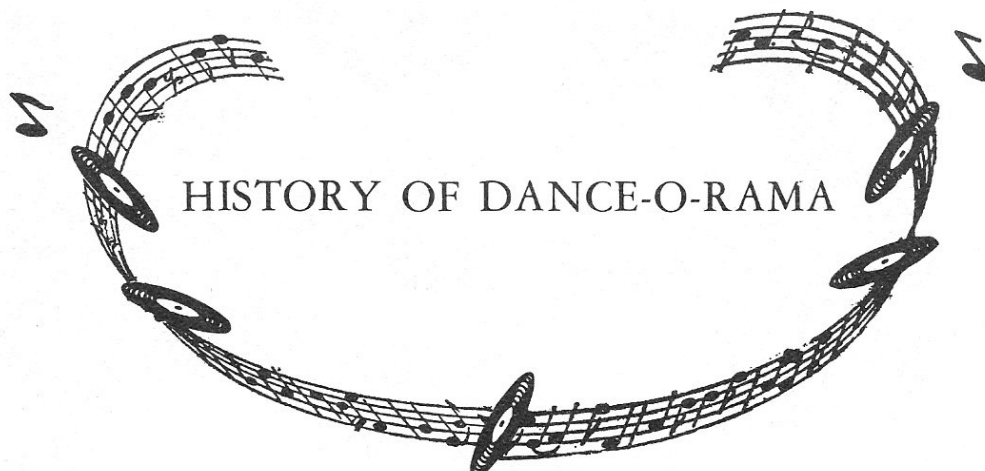

The first Dance-O-Rama under the direction of Anna Maria & Frank Cady was held April 18th, 1959 at Cutler Union, to celebrate 5 years of Square Dancing in the Rochester area. The callers were from the Rochester, Buffalo area.

In 1960, under the direction of Marian & George Kerridge, the Second Dance-O-Rama was held at Cutler Union. At this time we added a feature caller, Gloria Rios, who is now known as Gloria Roth.

In 1961 our Third Dance-O-Rama under the guidance of Betsy & Hamilton Stearn, at Cutler Union, featured the following callers, Hal Mason, Mike Stark, Tink Tinkler, Joe Reilly, Don Duffin and Art Harris.

Irene & Phil Warner were the Chairmen for the Fourth Dance-O-Rama in 1962, held at Cutler Union, featuring Ben Baldwin & Frank Mayerske along with other local callers.

With Bonnie & Earl Stafford at the helm in 1963, our Fifth Dance-O-Rama was held at Cutler Union. The featured callers were Singing Sam Mitchell and Dave Taylor.

In 1964 our Sixth Dance-O-Rama was moved to a new location, Kodak Park, under the guidance of Jane & Al Manning. The featured callers were Al Brundage, Earle Johnston, Lloyd Litman and Frank Mayerske.

Norma & Don Weekes took over the Chair for our Seventh Dance-O-Rama and moved us to Vince's Fifty Acres, where we featured Gloria Rios, Ben Baldwin, Bern Aubuchin and Dick Enderle.

In 1966 Lillion & Lou Stork led us through our Eighth Dance-O-Rama, this time at Bishop Kearney. The callers were Earle Park, Curley Custer, George Jabbuschand and Bob Norton.

Our Ninth Dance-O-Rama under the direction of Dorothy & Ambrose Baker was held in 1967 at Bishop Kearney. Callers were Red Bates, Jim Bower, John Hendron and Don Roberts.

In 1968 we called on Pepper & Bill Bibbler to chair Dance-O-Rama, our Tenth Dance. This was held at Bishop Kearney and calling for us was Bob Dubree, Dick Jones, Herb Keyes and Paul Pratt.

Arlene & Howie Newton were our leaders in 1969, for the Eleventh Dance-O-Rama. This was held at Bishop Kearney and featured Jack Lasry, Dave Stevenson, Jack Hague and Jerry Helt.

Barb & Bob Vreeland took over the reins for the Twelfth Dance-O-Rama in 1970, after Clive Bubb had to bow out. Again the dance was held at Bishop Kearney and featured Jack May, Jim Mayo, Singing Sam Mitchell, and Ron Schneider.

In 1971 Eileen & Bill Wilkinson took over the leadership and moved us to Greece Athena. Calling for us was Earl Johnston, Reath Blickenderfer and Gloria & Johnny Roth. This was our Thirteenth Dance-O-Rama.

The Robert L. Bourne Memorial Dance-O-Rama was number Fourteen. Barb & Ned Hasbrouck took over the leadership after the untimely death of Bob. This was our second year at Greece Athena and featured Deuce Williams, Dave Hass, Jerry Haag and Art Harris.

Now we come to 1973 Dance-O-Rama, held at an entirely new place and we hope for years to come at the same place RIT Campus. Calling for our dance this year is John Hendron, Kip Garvey, Bob Brundage and Bud Redmond. For the first time in the history of this event, we are featuring National Round Dance Leaders, Phil and Norma Roberts.

From the beginning, Charlie and Perkie Tucker have taken care of the rounds with the help of our local cuer's. Charlie & Perkie were instrumental in bringing the Roberts to our Rochester area, for which we are indeed fortunate.

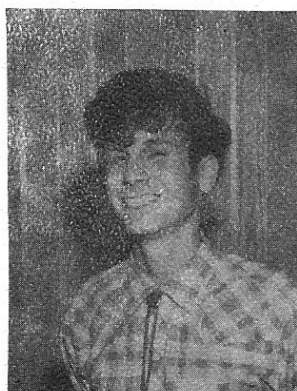

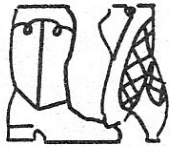

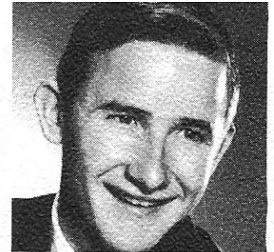


BOB BRUNDAGE

Of the thousands who call square dances today, relatively few can boast of successfully bridging the gap from the traditional period into today's contemporary field. One of these is Bob Brundage. Although Bob has traveled in many areas over the past 15 or 20 years, the main concentration of his calling time is spent with a home club program. Bob and his wife, Fran, have provided inspiration and guidance over the years not only to many young callers but to dancers and dancer groups in the area. His ability to call a variety of dance types from the traditional to the

latest pop release marks Bob for a continuing successful calling career.

KIP GARVEY



A charter member of one of the area's first teen clubs, Kip Garvey soon tried his hand at calling and in 1964 organized his first teen club, the Y-L Cats, in Lawrence, Massachusetts. His first adult group came into being in 1966 and the next year Kip began traveling to other clubs to fill guest calling spots.

In 1968 Kip graduated from Merrimack College in New England, thanks to square dancing. Since it was because of fees received for calling that he financed most of his college education, he ran a free "thank you" dance to show his appreciation for all that square dancing had done for him. All square dancers in New England were invited to attend the affair. Kip and his wife, Kathy, met in college and were married soon after graduation. They have a little daughter, Leanne. Although Kathy wasn't a square dancer when they met, she soon learned, is now actively involved with Kip and has become his greatest asset.



JOHN HENDRON

Back in 1950 Kankakee, Illinois was home to Bea and John Hendron, and it was here that they were first introduced to square dancing. John began calling in 1957, and in spite of the fact that the activity seemed to be at a stand-still he soon found himself teaching for several groups each year and calling regularly for four clubs. In 1963 John was transferred to the New England area, where he was told people were hard to meet and know. The Hendrons have found just the opposite to be true. Still teaching beginners and conducting workshops, John also calls for eleven clubs

in the area. He has served on staff at Kirkwood Lodge, Boyne Highlands, Funstitute and Hidden Valley and calls numerous festivals around the country each year. A recording artist for a number of years, John most recently joined with Ken Anderson of New York to form a new square dance label call Jay-Bar-Kay. His latest recording is "You're the One." John and Bea have two sons, Gary, 23 and Greg, 12, the latter having aspirations to one day becoming a caller too.

BUD REDMOND



Bud is a steam fitter by trade and for the past 12 years has been piping the square dances to many in the Lewiston, Buffalo and Canadian area. He and Mike reside in Lewiston and have 3 children. Presently he calls for 5 clubs on a regular basis. His fantastic patter makes him a great favorite.



PHIL & NORMA ROBERTS

Phil and Norma Roberts are from New Albany, Indiana. They have served ten years on the staffs of DANCE-A-CADE, ROND-A-CADE and CANADA-A-CADE. They have been round dancing for 15 years and teaching rounds for 10 years. They taught PAS-DE-DEUX exhibition group. Their latest dances are Mr. Sandman and Brighteyes.
