- 2. Open Houses
 - a. In Nov send generic flyer to all clubs. Also send to Sid Marshall for Promenader link.
 - b. Goal of flyer is to assist clubs with 2020 open house flyers.
 - c. We have two flyers the clubs can customize for their own use
 - d. Flyer in Power Point designed by Dave Collins
 - e. Flyer in Word designed by Amy Aeckerle and Jeff Blood
 - f. Jeff Blood to prepare e-mail cover letter to be sent to club presidents with both generic flyers
 - g. Promotions Committee will be available to assist clubs with using the generic flyers
 - h. Debbie Blood to follow up with Warren Olson to outline flyer printing process
- 3. Promotions Committee to create Events Calendar to assist in the scheduling of events to minimize scheduling conflicts
